October 25-28, 2018 John's Pass Seafood Festival

As we celebrate the 37th annual occurrence of this event we are anticipating large crowds. Through our partnership with the Pinellas County Sheriff's Department we have taken heavy measures to ensure traffic patterns and other precautions will provide the utmost safety for your community and visitors. Road closures will go into effect at 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 25.

Please note the following changes made this year to ensure this is possible;

129th Avenue East – Security guard will be posted along with a resident's only sign to regulate traffic.

129th Ave East & Pelican Lane – This will be the location of event safety and security staff, here there will only be one way in and one way out.

Merchants please be aware festival set up begins Thursday morning. 129th, Village Blvd. and Boardwalk Place will be closed for deliveries at 10am and will reopen Monday.
